

Capital city ready to welcome pilgrims

Thiruvananthapuram: Much arrangements have been made in the capital city to provide temporary shelters and free food to Sabarimala pilgrims. Temporary shelters will be provided at OTC Hanuman temple, Sreekanteswaram temple and Thiruvallam Sree Parasurama temple. The Travancore Devaswom Board (TDB) will set up infrastructure facilities such as temporary pilgrim shelters, drinking water, toilets and parking facilities for vehicles at the three places.

Free food will be served to pilgrims at Sreekanteswaram and Thiruvallam. Special counters would be established at OTC Hanuman temple, Sreekanteswaram and Thiruvallam Sree Parasurama temple for pilgrims to book Abhishekam tickets.
