

Special Poojas for TN Flood Victims Today at Sabarimala

SABARIMALA: Travancore Devaswom Board president Prayar Gopalakrishnan said special poojas would be conducted at the Lord Ayyappa temple here on Sunday for the people of Tamil Nadu who were in dire straits following the devastating floods.

Addressing a news conference here on Saturday, Gopalakrishnan said as part of the special rituals to be conducted on the advice of the thantri, ashtadravyaganapathi homam would be held in the morning and pushapabhishekam in the evening.

Special poojas will be conducted also at Malikappuram.

“In connection with the special rituals, Bhagavathi Seva will be held in the evening after the deeparadhana,” he said. “At Pampa Lord Ganapathi temple and other small temples, special poojas will be conducted for the early recovery of the flood affected from their sufferings,” he said.
