

TN Floods Left Rs 15-cr Dent in Sabarimala Revenue: TDB

KOLLAM: Tamil Nadu floods have made a serious dent in the revenue earned by the hill shrine this year, Travancore Dewaswom Board president Prayar Gopalakrishnan said here on Sunday. The temple revenue is less by Rs15 crore compared to previous year, he told reporters.

The total income received until Saturday is Rs103 crore. The temple should have received a total of Rs118 crore by this time. He said discussions were held with the Forest Department which has agreed to make temporary arrangements to ensure water supply for pilgrims.
